These special sessions are mandatory for children preparing for First Communion. **Please plan in advance to ensure that your child and at least one parent will be in attendance.** If you are aware of a conflict that cannot be avoided and must take priority please inform Mandie and Father Harris as soon as possible to make alternate arrangements. The Eucharist is the “source and summit” of our faith, and placing priority on your child's formation will bear great fruit in the future.
